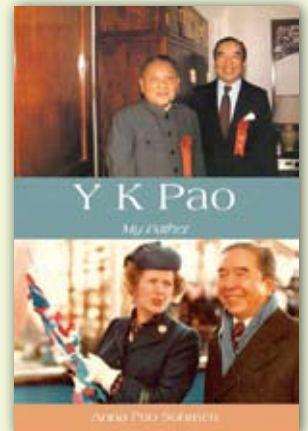

## BOOK REVIEWS

### 《Y K Pao, My Father》by Anna Pao Sohmen

The author Prof. Anna Pao Sohmen (蘇包陪慶教授 '62) remembers her father, Sir Yue-kong Pao (包玉剛爵士), as "A Global Citizen with a Chinese heart". Sir YK Pao (1918-1991) founded World-wide Shipping, a Hong Kong based company, in 1955 and rose to become one of the world's biggest shipping tycoons by the mid-1970's. The legacy of Sir YK Pao extends far beyond his shipping empire: "Pao became an unofficial Chinese ambassador at large, forging a strong relationship with the architect of China's reform, Deng Xiaoping, at the dawn of China's economic transformation and during the discussions about Hong Kong's future." This book offers a glimpse into the making of this great man. Anna is a business leader, educator and an active alumna of Ying Wa, who generously supports the school's initiatives both in the arts and fundraising.

鍾陳可慰女士以護士身份在第二次世界大戰時逃難至昆明，及後加入飛虎隊，並冒生命危險服務飛越中印邊境最險峻的喜馬拉雅山脈“駝峰”航線。她自謙“平凡”，卻處處體現堅毅、智慧和對生活的熱誠。這自傳由她口述，女兒鍾端玲博士(Dr Deborah Chung '69)整理。鍾博士去年9月曾在銅鑼灣中華基督教會公理堂以母親的經歷作專題演講，分享她蒙福的生命，成就天恩處處。
