

6. Newsletters

Two issues of the Alumnae Newsletter have been published and sent to members by post and by email since the last AGM. The October 2021 issue featured an interview with the director, Miss Mabel Cheung, and the producer, Miss Wong Wai, of the movie. The spring issue (March 2022) reported the Movie Gala held on 1 December 2021 and the Sports day, which had been suspended for 2 years due to Covid-19. Approximately 1800 hard copies of the newsletters were distributed.



Two issues of the Overseas Alumnae Newsletter have also been published and posted on the AA website over this year to report the news and activities of overseas alumnae groups. The headlines of the 13th edition (October 2021) and 14th edition (March 2022) were the obituary and memories of Miss Jenkins, and the sharing of alumnae from different countries.



Background



Our association was founded in 1922 by Miss M.M. Hogben, the Principal serving Ying Wa from 1920 to 1925. On 1 March 2006, it was incorporated as a limited company.

7. Homepage

Since the launch of the new AA mobile-friendly homepage on 29 August 2018, most of the original content has been migrated to the new domain. The update and maintenance is supported by an AA Management Team comprised of school staff, alumnae and Council members.

8. Facebook Group and Instagram

The "Ying Wa Girls' School Alumnae Association" Facebook Group has been put in place to share news and activities of graduates. Alumnae, students and



parents, teachers, school staff and honorary members recommended by the AA Council are welcome to join the Group and share their messages. To improve the management of the page, some rules were set for members' reference.



An Instagram account (@ywgsaa) is also created for posting AA updates.

Due to COVID-19, most activities requiring physical presence have been cancelled. A special working group has been set up to explore the possibilities of organizing online talks and activities on Facebook or Instagram to promote interaction among us.

9. Caring Team



The Caring Team aims to provide mutual support and strengthen our bonding with alumnae and teaching staff. During the year, we maintained close contact with some overseas alumnae, former school teachers and former principals.

A bouquet of flowers and a birthday card were sent to our former Vice-Principal, Mrs. KWAN Yeuk Laan, in August 2021, to celebrate her 101st birthday.





To express our gratitude to serving teachers, AA committee members have made a small donation to treat them cakes and cookies in April 2021, and Mooncakes at Mid-autumn Festival in September 2021. The remaining amount of donation would be used for future treats when face-to-face lessons resume.

10. Alumnae Database & Membership

The database, regularly updated, aims to keep the latest information of our alumnae and facilitate communication between the AA and our fellow students. By February 2021, the alumnae database contained about 6 500 member records. A new membership fee of \$zero was adopted in last General Meeting held on 27 March 2021. 11. Overseas Chapters

The Council is pleased to connect with various overseas chapters spread around the world. We feel indebted to the committed contact persons for their

12. Alumnae Choir




Due to the COVID-19 epidemic, Ying Wa Girls' School Alumnae Choir practices have been suspended since early 2020.

14. School Archives Collection
