- Term of office** All members of the Council shall retire at every 2- yearly Annual General Meeting.

- Regulations of Nomination & Election**
1. Nominees, nominators, seconders or voters should be ordinary members of the Association.
 2. Each nominee should be nominated and seconded by an ordinary member of the Association.
 3. Prior consent of nominees should be sought before nomination.
 4. Each ordinary member is eligible to complete one Ballot Form.
 5. The nominees receiving the highest number of votes shall become the Council members, who will elect among themselves the President, Vice-President, Honorary Secretaries and Honorary Treasurer.
 6. Duly completed Nomination Form should reach YWGSAAAL by mail (76 Robinson Road, Mid-Levels) or email (alumnae@ywgs.edu.hk) on or before **Wednesday, 22 February 2023**.
