

It is most exciting to have gathered all the Ying Wa girls together as an extended family to view the work by our fellow alumna, Mabel Cheung. On behalf of all the alumnae, I thank you, Mabel, for sharing with us this exclusive story of Jackie Chan and his family.

Movie making is a unique form of art. It encompasses many aspects including script writing, drama, technical art, photography and music. Hong Kong had seen the heyday of movie-making and is now rethinking, repositioning itself in the industry. With competitive labour cost and talent pool in neighbouring countries and PRC. Hong Kong faces an uphill battle. However, I am very happy that during my assignment as the Chairman of the Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts. Bethanie House, built in 1875, has been resurrected, restored and renovated. The Film School will be housed there for Hong Kong's talented directors, script writers, producers and actors. I hope this will invigorate the Hong Kong film industry.

My interest in the arts spans across visual arts, music, drama and dance. Ying Wa had provided me with an excellent education, not only in the building of our faith in God, but also opened my eyes to other aspects of life beyond the knowledge from books. Being the choir leader. I took a special interest in singing on top of private lessons in piano. Thereby I learned about European composers. The participation at the Music Festivals taught me the importance of cultural events not only as a means to de-stress, but also to express oneself through media other than writing. Drama Club at Ying Wa was invigorating because it taught us how to organize, motivate each other and work as a team. Taking ballet lessons at Carol Bateman helped stretch one's body to the limits. It also meant perseverance.

Teaching arts in various forms is definitely a very important aspect of education. It stimulates the power of association, unleashes emotions of teenagers and enhances creativity. Performing Arts can also be used as teaching medium whereby learning becomes three dimensional and visual memory becomes more vivid. My sixteen years of involvement with the Academy for Performing Arts confirmed these beliefs. My own personal experience in pottery, opera, choreography, choir and modern dance at University level as minors has also taught me to think out of the box. Creativity empowers us in this new generation of knowledge based on ideas. There are greater needs to think laterally to solve problems in the ever more complex and competitive world we live in. And there is an increased urge to prepare and educate our young to face the challenges of the future.

Ying Wa has always put much emphasis on extra-curricular activities. Long may it last. I wish Ying Wa success in continuing to give an allrounded education to girls in Hong Kong.

Ying Wa's encounters with Fund-raising

Interview with Mrs. Ruth Lee, Principal of YWGS Reporter: Does "Fund-raising" have any special meaning to

Mrs. Lee: Fund-raising is a term too familiar in the education arena in the recent decade. Besides educating our younger generations, school administrators nowadays have to develop financial resources to enhance quality education to meet challenges of the new era.

Reporter: How about in the past? Is "Fund-raising" part of Ying Wa's history?

Mrs. Lee: Yes, when we look back into the history of Ying Wa, fund-raising is not a new venture. Right from its establishment and throughout the process of school development, money and how to raise sufficient amounts were issues that were constantly on the mind of our fore-runners.

Reporter: Were there any memorable fund-raising events?

Mrs. Lee: There were several fund-raising drives but I would share the one back in 1927. A large-scale fund-raising campaign was launched for the school extension project. For that project, the school divided the entire student body into eight teams. Each team was made up of 27 students who were led by a captain and assistant captain. Miss Hutchinson later wrote in the annals of Ying Wa on this momentous day:

"On October 1st – a glorious day when the sun seemed to be smiling approval upon their undertaking – the girls embarked upon their venture. Half an hour before the close of school (it was Saturday) the entire school assembled. We sang 'we build our school on Thee, O Lord' and then we listened to a speech by the chairman in which some very good advice as well as words of warning as to how to collect were given. Then the teamleader-in-chief gave a most inspiring speech, and ended by calling upon the school to repeat together after her words which have this meaning:

'With one heart, one virtue, one strength of purpose; For God, for our country, and for Ying Wa!'

Then she waved a flag, and the whole school joined in the cry: 'Ying Wa for ten thousand years! Ying Wa for ten thousand years! Ying Wa for ten thousand years! The School was dismissed, and I heard later on in the day that 'Ying Wa was everywhere! The whole street was Ying Wa!' There was no excuse whatever for people who professed never to have heard of us!" [P. 79 School History]

Reporter: How do you feel about the fund-raising efforts of the Alumnae Association?

Mrs. Lee: I am indeed very grateful for their love and support to our alma mater. For those who are in Ying Wa, we know our fore-runners needed extra resources not just to enhance quality education or to maintain a competitive edge. Instead, they were striving for a more noble purpose: to enlighten and nurture young girls for the betterment of the future generations. This was clearly expressed in Miss Helen Davies' letter to the former London Missionary Society:

"We want the young for Christ, and we want them to become as perfect and complete in Christian character as it lies in our power to help them to be. We need to begin early, and train the future teachers, nurses, Biblewomen, and especially mothers, who will send their influence down through all the future generations." (P. 32 School History)

Today, we continue this spirit and we focus on the real nurture of young talents so that they can serve and shine in the community, our society, motherland and the world.

Reporter: What would you like to say to the participants of the Movie Gala?

Mrs. Lee: I am glad that we all join hands at the Movie Gala to write a new page of the same noble vision for Ying Wa. I would also like to thank them for taking part in the endeavour and sharing our passion.

轉到英國文學班。她非常感激Miss Moore 無微不至 的指引,比婉婷自己更了解其興趣及潛能。也許沒 有Miss Moore 的提點,她的事業將會改寫。

婉婷中學時的香港女導演極少,她也沒有立志做 轉演。在香港大學英國文學系畢業後,她到了英 國Bristol University 唸戲劇及視覺藝術,BBC Bristol 就在附近,她便當上production assistant, 發覺演藝行業並不是外面傳的男盜女娼,亦令她 可應用所學知識。所以後來她便到了美國紐約大 學修讀電影碩士課程。

婉婷初試略聲即一鳴驚人·她的處女作《非法移 民》榮獲1985年香港電影金像獎最佳轉演及第30 屆亞太影展評審團大獎·兩年後製作的《秋天的 童話》亦已成為亞洲經典電影之一·其後的電影作 品包括《七小福》、《八両金》、《宋家皇朝》、 《玻璃之城》及《北京樂與路》。《龍的深處一 失落的拼圖》是她所執導的第一齣紀錄片,於 2003年2月在柏林國際電影節首映並獲得廣泛好 評。去年,婉婷亦替中央電視台執導用以紀念中 國電影百年誕辰的舞台音樂劇《電影之歌》。婉 婷執導的作品無論在票房及藝術成就方面均十分 出色,作為她的校友,我們實在與有榮焉。

現在・婉婷多在北京從事舞台音樂劇創作及導演工作・希望可在多地上演。

婉婷非常感激母校的教育,與同屆同學亦維持緊密聯繫,她們至今仍每月聚會一次,議稱自己是「八婆會」(Bart)。基於對英華的關愛,她非常熱心地協助商借《龍的深處一失落的拼圖》的播映權,並積極參與電影籌款動機得更多資源使它的優質教育辦得更好,更深化。

龍的深處─ 失落的拼圖 TRACES OF A DRAGON: Jackie Chan & His Lost Family

成龍在電影圈是通天曉,但到了數年前,他才真正認識自己的家族和他自己。

這位生於一九五零年代的巨星,於當時經濟尚未起飛的香港出生。他一直以為自己生於一個簡單的家庭,有一位勤奮工作的父親,和一位天生溫和的母親。他以為自己姓陳,是父母的獨生子。直至一天,她母親的健康惡化,他父親於是決定將家族的秘密告訴他:原來成龍父母的背景殊不簡單,原來他還有幾個兄弟姊妹在中國失散了,更甚的是,原來他並非姓陳!

這齣電影探索成龍和他失散了的家族的故事,並將他和他兄弟姊妹所經歷的非一般童年拼湊起來。從最初的撲朔迷離,到後來水落石出,我們發現,成龍的父親是一名間諜,於蔣介石年代為國民黨效力,而他的母親也絕不是普通的家庭主婦。從尋源的過程中,我們亦體會到,當中國經歷兩次世界大戰、國共內戰及翻天覆地的文化大革命時,那些因家國憂患而被親人遺棄的兒童,是何等悽慘無援。


到最後,我們忽然醒覺,這個故事不單屬於成龍和他的 家族,它可能屬於近代所有經歷過國家憂患的中國家庭。
